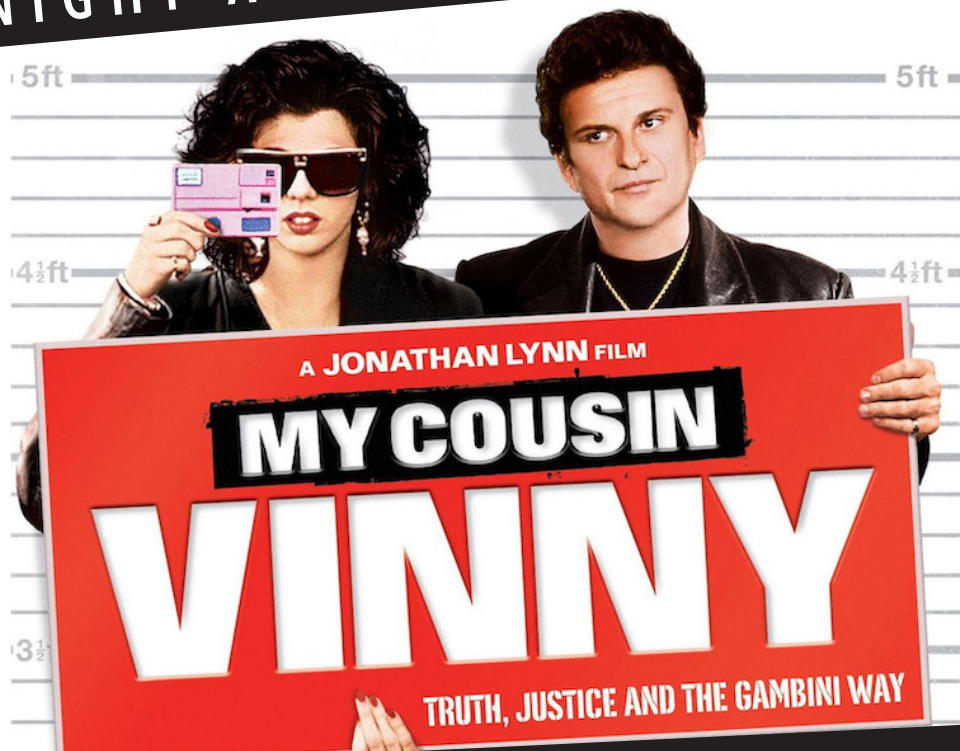

## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

### About the Movie

With nearly a full hour of trial on film, *My Cousin Vinny* is a favorite of law professors, but it's also a wonderful comedy and was a big box office hit. Director Jonathan Lynn has a law degree from Cambridge and he took his background and made a great film even better. *My Cousin Vinny* is a film that stands up, from the classroom to the Supreme Court. Hey, you might even learn something!

### About the CLE

Our panelists will talk about wrongful convictions and their impact on policy, the system, the wrongfully convicted and our ability to prevent future injustice. An overall wrongful conviction estimate of a half percent extrapolates to about 5,000 wrongful felony convictions and the imprisonment of more than 2,000 innocent persons in the United States every year. The DOJ has initiated an Actual Innocence Project, designed to ensure that there are no persons serving time in Delaware correctional facilities who have evidence that establishes their innocence. In the movie *My Cousin Vinny*, two innocent college students on their way to school have been charged with the murder of a convenience store owner. The circumstantial evidence looks damning, but the worst thing they have going against them is their lawyer's sweeping lack of legal experience.

A wrongful conviction means that people may have been convicted without full access to justice. Providing that access means ensuring that people who have committed crimes are appropriately punished, and it means ensuring that people who have not committed crimes are not punished. We will discuss the assurance that we are fulfilling that responsibility.

Justice means that consideration of information from those who are in possession of physical, scientific, or documentary evidence suggesting no criminal wrongdoing. This may include forensic evidence, audio or video evidence, electronic evidence such as e-mail or phone records, or other physical evidence.
