DSBA ESTATES AND TRUSTS SECTION MEETING

April 3, 2018

In accordance with notice duly given, a meeting of the Estates and Trusts Section of the Delaware State Bar Association was held on April 3, 2018, beginning at 3:30 p.m. at the offices of Bessemer Trust Company of Delaware, N.A., 1007 N. Orange Street, Suite 1450, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.

Mark E. Doyle, Chair, called the meeting to order.

 - Mr. Doyle reminded the Section that the Committee is in the process of establishing a subcommittee that will oversee possible revisions to 12 *Del*. *Code* section 3322 regarding the hiring of agents by fiduciaries. Mr. Doyle updated the Section of the status of 2017 Trust Act. He attended a DSBA Executive Committee meeting on March 6 in order to handle questions raised regarding the committee's consideration of the draft Act. At that meeting, the Executive Committee gave conditional DSBA-level approval to the Act, the condition being the submission of the final draft Act to the Court of Chancery and confirmation that the Court wishes to take no position. The Committee has followed up with a submission of the draft Act to the Register in Chancery, and a Committee representative will call into the Court to confirm its receipt and to determine if the Court wishes to take a position.

- c. <u>CLE Committee Report of Committee</u>. On behalf of the Committee, Mr. Swenson stated that there was no report this month.

The Committee will reconvene once there is a model act to review and from which to work.
- 3. Old Business Status of Trust Act 2018. Mr. Doyle's update on the status of the draft 2018 Trust Act was provided during the Trust Act Committee report.
- 4. New Business Officer Nominations Secretary, Estates & Trusts Section, 2018–2019 Legislative Year. Mr. Doyle informed the Section that nominations were needed for a Secretary of the Section for the coming year. Once nominations are collected, the last three Chairs of Section will meet to decide on the slate of officer nominees for 2018-2019.
